Building your Network (Board of Directors)

- •Contacts yet to be discovered (the seeking process)


Expand on your List: After creating your list, you can start thinking about who these people can connect you with. If you don't ask, you'll never know!





Do's and Don'ts's of Networking:

- •Don't move too fast in building your personal network
- •Seek out individuals who consistently make good decisions in their lives
- •Identify those who will challenge you to do better
- •Listen to their advice but realize it is only advice
- •Be careful when adding personal friends who have know you for a long time
- •Put a lot thought into the process and be willing to make changes
- •Search for those who want the best for you in both your work and faith
- •Value the strength of diversity and breadth of experience
- •Develop a team you can trust!
- •Ultimately it is still your responsibility to make the decisions in your life





